What you need to know

A provider number uniquely identifies you and the location where you provide services. You can use your new provider number for services from the effective date above, however please wait 2 business days before submitting claims with this number.

You need to provide your name and provider number on the patient's account/receipt or any bulk bill account when providing Medicare services.

You can only claim Medicare benefits if:

1. you are working in a private capacity, and you receive no other government funding for these services, **or** there is a Ministerial direction that Medicare benefits will be payable at this location, **and**
2. you gave us your ABN details and banking details when applying for the provider number.

For more information about working in a private capacity, or Ministerial directions, refer to Subsection 19(2) or 19(5) of the Health Insurance Act 1973.

Your provider number is subject to your continued professional registration. You need to make sure you are aware of any legislative requirements and conditions on your registration when using your provider number.

What you must tell us

If you are a medical practitioner who is a temporary resident, you must immediately tell us of any change to your residency status.

When you become a permanent resident or Australian citizen you need to separately satisfy section 19AA **from the date your residency status changes** or your eligibility for Medicare billing will stop.

To satisfy section 19AA, you need to be a recognised general practitioner, specialist or consultant physician for Medicare purposes or be registered in an approved program under section 3GA of the Health Insurance Act 1973. This is in addition to holding a section 19AB exemption for the location.

If your application has been approved under a 19AB exemption, please ensure you're practicing within the requirements of your exemption and advise if there are changes to your circumstances.

If your residency changes, please send a copy of your permanent residency visa or citizenship documents.
